Experience shows that students who do not gain adequate reading skills by the end of Third Grade struggle to succeed in later grades, where they learn mostly by reading. Promoting poor readers does not work, as many continue to fall further and further behind. Ohio has once again mandated the Third Grade Reading Guarantee (TGRG). The TGRG helps to ensure that every struggling reader receives the support they need to be able to learn and achieve. Teachers assess each student's reading skills at the beginning of the school year. If a child is reading below grade

level, the school creates a Reading Improvement and Monitoring Plan (RIMP) specifically for that child. This is done for all of our students in grades K-3.

Third Graders will take the Ohio State Test in English and Language Arts (ELA) on October 16th. This exam will give teachers a clearer picture of the skill level of each Third Grader so that they can better plan and teach students according to their needs.

I love Fall- the changing colors and the amazing smells that the season brings. This year we will celebrate the season in cooperation with our PTO during school hours. As always, we appreciate candy donations at this time of the year. Our teachers will definitely put them to good use during some of the festivities we are planning.

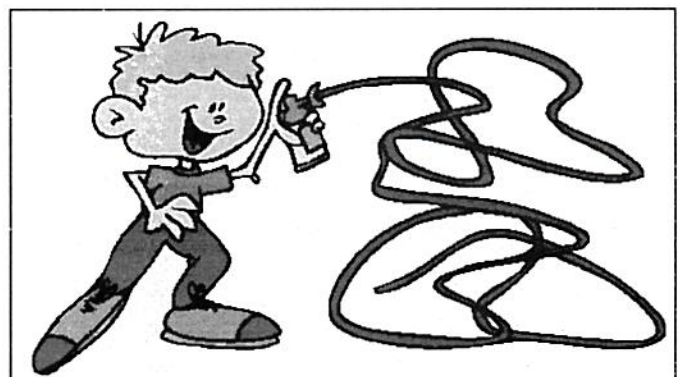

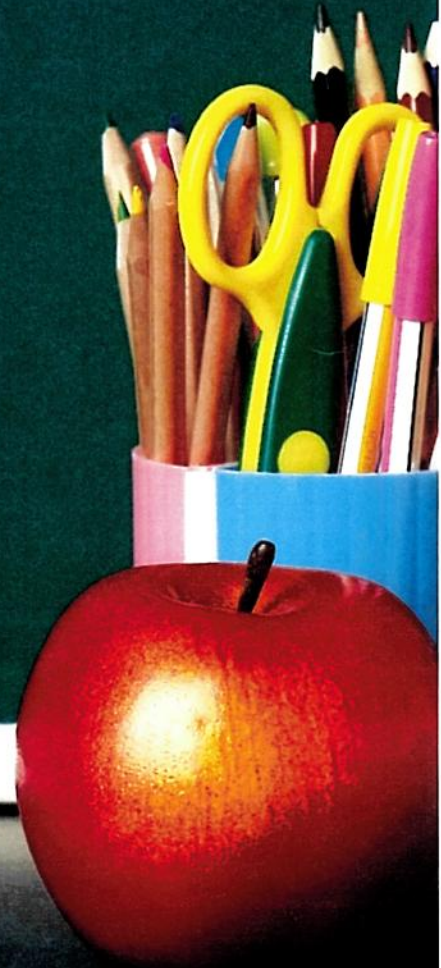
